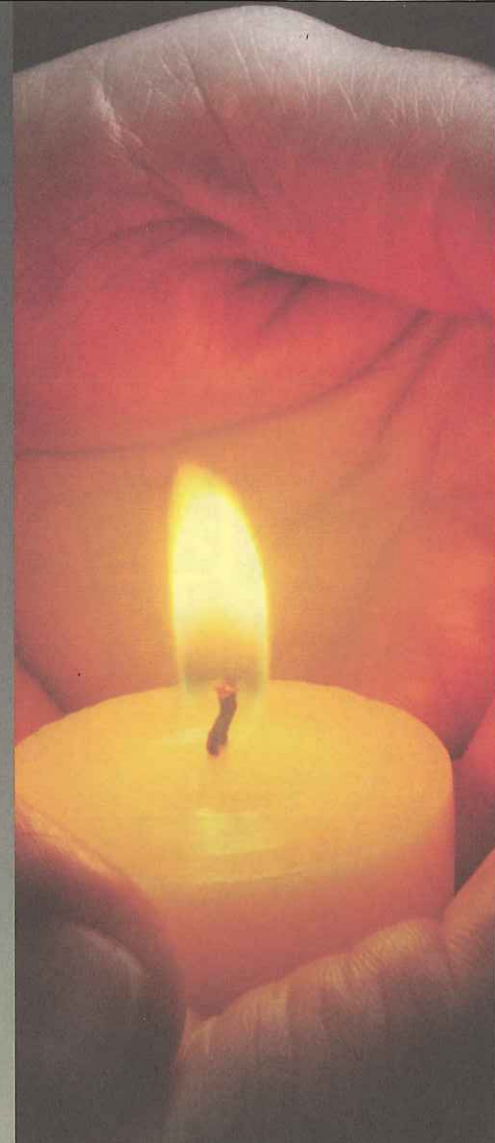
MAKE A DIFFERENCE
